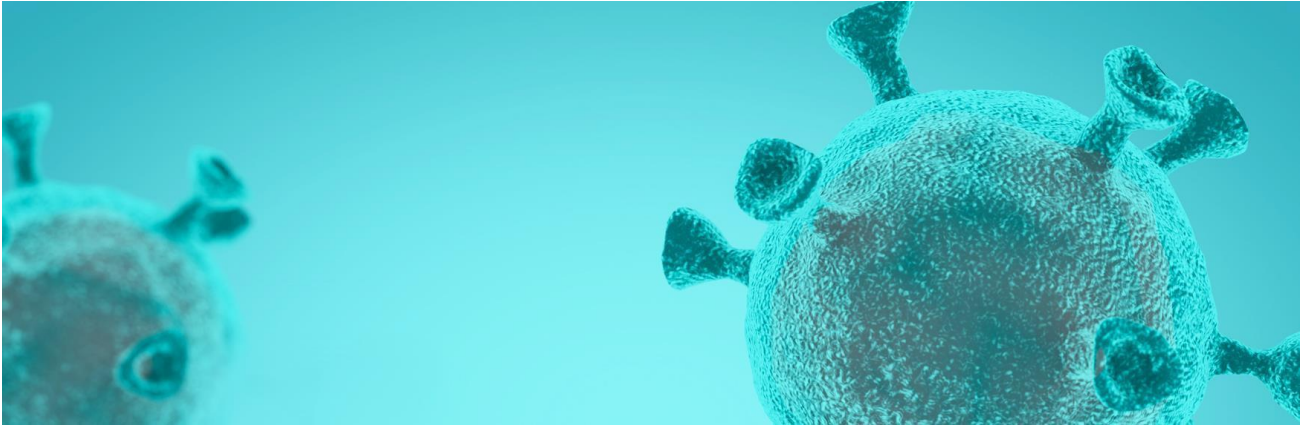


ONTIER MEXICO - COVID 19

SUSPENSION OF TERMS AND DEADLINES INHERENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AND PROCEDURES; AS WELL AS THE GRANTING OF ADMINISTRATIVE FACILITIES FOR THE FULFILLMENT OF TAX OBLIGATIONS, DERIVED FROM THE CONTINGENCY CAUSED BY THE COVID-.19 VIRUS.

March 27, 2020

As a result of the contingency caused by the COVID-19 virus, the government of Mexico City has decided to implement a series of actions aimed at controlling and combating its existence and transmission.

By virtue of the above, on March 20, 2020, the Public Administration of Mexico City published the Agreement suspending the terms and deadlines inherent in administrative proceedings and procedures, and granting administrative facilities for compliance with tax obligations, which will come into force from March 23, 2020.

The Agreement orders that for public health reasons the terms and deadlines for the practice of proceedings and proceedings be suspended Administrative proceedings before Mexico City public administration agencies, decentralized entities, city halls, and other entities including “*sustanciación*” proceedings, notifications, citations, summonses,

Injunctions, agreements, proceedings, resolutions, appeals of non-conformity, revocation or any other means of defense, and other actions.

The suspension also includes the receipt of documents and reports, verification visits, public service at the desk, requests for reports or documents, as well as any administrative act issued by persons working in the public service that affects the legal sphere of individuals.

The period of suspension (“Period of Suspension”) will be from March 23 to April 19, 2020; therefore, the days that constitute the Period of Suspension shall be counted as non-working days.

When there is a period of time for the filing of promotions between the referred Period of Suspension, such period shall be extended until the following business day.

It is important to point out that the service to the public at the counters and the performance of procedures that are carried out before the agencies, decentralized entities, City Halls and entities of the Public Administration of Mexico City in matters of urban development, construction and real estate sector, as well as those necessary for the granting of instruments related to real estate before public notaries, are exempted from said Suspension Period.

Finally, the terms for compliance with the tax obligations contained in the Mexico City Tax Code, consisting of the filing of returns, as well as the making of payments to be made in the month of April 2020, are extended until April 30 of the same year.
